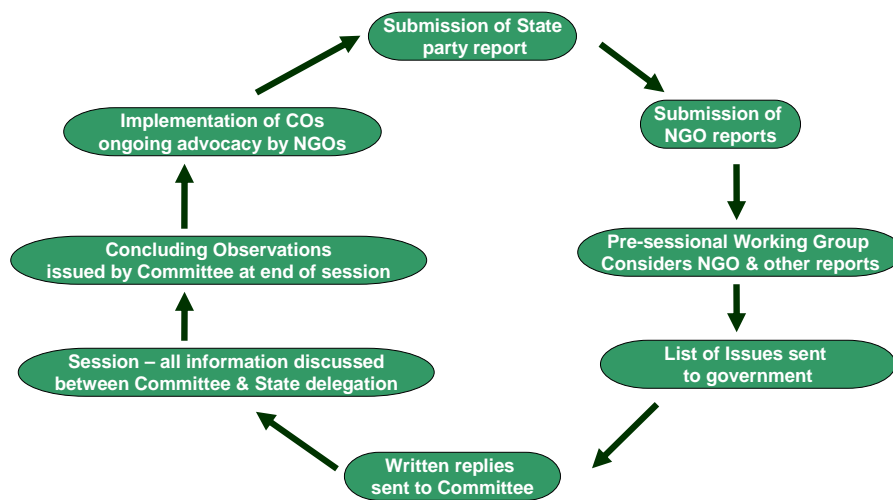

Entry Points for NGOs

- **National Consultation: drafting the State report**
- **NGO alternative report**
- **Pre-session meeting and List of Issues**
- **Written Replies from the State**
- **CRC Committee Session**
- **Follow-up to Concluding Observations and Recommendations**

The Role of the NGO Group

- Facilitate CRC Committee interaction with child rights NGOs, particularly national NGOs, in all countries;
- Provide technical support throughout the reporting cycle;
- Produce CRC reporting guides, including on child and youth participation.
